

Cancer Faculty admits its first Fellows



Congratulations to Dr Libby Hardy and Mr Steve Williamson, who have been admitted as the first Fellows of the Faculty of Cancer Pharmacy. Libby and Steve both joined the College when the Faculty was set up earlier this year. They were both already in senior positions in the NHS, Libby as Lead Pharmacist for the Peninsula Cancer Network based at the Royal Devon and Exeter Hospital, and Steve as Consultant Pharmacist in Cancer Services for the North of England Cancer Network, based at Northumbria Healthcare NHS Trust.

The assessment interviews were held at the College on Friday 10th October and the Panel, chaired by Geoff Saunders, was unanimous in recommending that they were both eligible for promotion to Fellowship. This recommendation was approved by the Fellowship Committee, chaired by Professor Joy Wingfield.

The new Fellows received their Faculty Fellowship Certificates from College Chief Executive, Ian Simpson, at the first AGM of the Faculty, which was held during the BOPA Symposium in Liverpool on Saturday 18th October.
